- 1) Facility Hours: The Wallace County Rec Center is available to use 24 hours, accessible with your PIN code, fob, or key card.
- 2) 24 Hour Video/Audio Surveillance at all times.
- 3) Wallace County Rec Center makes no assessment of your health status in participating in any type of program or activity. Please consult your physician prior to beginning any type of exercise program.
- 4) All participants/users must sign a "Wallace County Rec Center Membership Form" prior to using the facility.
- 5) Members are responsible for their access fob and or card, if issued one. Lost key cards and fobs will be replaced for a \$25 fee. If membership is discontinued, key card/ fob must be returned to the Wallace County Rec Center. Failure to do so will result in a \$25 fee.
- 6) All members who have paid their dues and completed the membership agreement and waiver will be issued a key card/ fob/ or PIN code which will allow them access to the Wallace County Rec Center. **Members are not allowed to give their key card/ fob/ or PIN code to individuals who do not belong to the Wallace County Rec Center. Doing so will result in an immediate suspension and/or cancellation of your membership. There will be no refund of dues.**
- 7) No one under the age of fourteen years (14) will be permitted to enter Wallace County Rec Center, unless participating in a scheduled children's class in the fitness class room and is being supervised by the instructor. Members age fourteen and fifteen must be with a parent or legal guardian while using the fitness center.
- 8) People are no longer considered dependents on their parents/guardians membership account above the age of 22. Once someone reaches the age of 23 they must purchase their own separate membership to use the facility.
- 9) Failure to pay the membership fee will result in suspension and/or cancellation of your membership and privilege to use the facility. No refunds will be issued on membership fee payments.
- 10) Guests may use the facility for a fee of \$10/week. Please contact 785-821-3831 to arrange paperwork and payment for a guest pass.
- 11) Report any accident(s) immediately to the Wallace County Recreation Department @ 785-821-3831 or 785-462-0139. This includes spills and breakage of equipment.
- 12) Dress Code: Shirts or tank tops must be worn at all times.
Clean, Non-marking soled shoes must be worn at all times.
No sandals, open-toed shoes, or boots are allowed.
Carry in shoes, no outside shoes. Shoes must be free of rocks, sand and mud.
- 13) Food, beverages, pop cans or open cups are NOT allowed in the building. Only drinks in closed, non-breakable containers are allowed in the facility.
- 14) Treat all equipment with care and disinfect each machine when you are finished using it. Cleaning supplies are provided for wiping the equipment off.
- 15) If you are unsure of how the equipment works, to avoid injury . . . **DO NOT USE.**
- 16) No cussing, harassing, intimidating behavior or physical exchange will be tolerated.
- 17) No bicycles, skates, skateboards, rollerblades, pets of any kind are allowed in the building.
- 18) No alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs are allowed on the property.
- 19) Lost or damaged equipment will be the responsibility of the individual to replace.
- 20) The Wallace County Rec Center is not responsible for lost or stolen property. Members are discouraged from bringing valuable items to the Wallace County Rec Center.

- 21) In an emergency, i.e. fire, exit and call 911. Move across the street in the quickest manner possible. The closest tornado shelter is in the basement of the Sunflower Bed and Breakfast.
- 22) Misuse or abuse of the facility or equipment will not be tolerated. The Wallace County Rec Center has video surveillance and will be monitored. Your access will be revoked and fob/card must be returned &/or will be deactivated.
- 23) Wallace County Rec Center may revoke key privileges at the Wallace County Recreation Department Board of Directors discretion and there is a zero tolerance level. This includes, but is not limited to, conduct that constitutes safety hazards, physical abuse, mental abuse, or failure to comply with the Wallace County Rec Center Rules and Regulations.
- 24) A First Aid Kit is located in **center room attached to the wall.**
- 25) A Hazardous Waste kit is located the **center room attached to the wall.**
- 26) NO EQUIPMENT should leave the Wellness Center.
- 27) NO EQUIPMENT can be brought into the Wallace County Rec Center without the Wallace County Rec Center approval.
- 28) All participants must leave the premises clean and make sure lights, TVs, and equipment are turned off.
- 29) Wallace County Rec Center has the right to change any of these rules and policies at any time.
- 30) Remember the facility rules are for everyone's safety and enjoyment. Please respect other participants at all times.
